FAQ

Who can register to play?

Any fun-loving woman 21 and up!

Can I join any team I want?

No, all teams have limited space on their rosters and teams in the 7v7 Hardcore Division are open to recruited players only. When you register you may request specific teams, but understand that teams are filled on a first-come, first served based on available openings.

What special equipment is required?

Players are strongly encouraged to wear cleats. Cleats must be plastic, absolutely NO metal cleats. IWFFL will provide players with a team shirt (yours to keep) and all athletic equipment needed to play (flags, balls, etc.). If you have had issues with twisted ankles or knees, please wear stabilizer braces (no metal). It's always better to be safe than sorry! Many injuries can be prevented with proper protection.

How long are games?

Games consist of two 30-minute halves with a 5 minute break.

Do I have to commit to ALL games?

Not at all! Each of our teams has a roster that can handle some absences here and there. We expect that players will take summer vacations and have other obligations from time to time. *However, we ask that you look over your summer plans to be sure you can make at least 60% of the games. If you know in advance that you cannot make half of the games, we ask that you wait until next year to sign up. Teams compete most effectively when all players are committed.*

What if something happens and I can't play?

You need to tell us ASAP if you will not be playing in IWFFL this season because we usually have a waiting list. If you decide not to play, your registration fee will be considered a donation to the league. We do not make a habit of refunding Player Registration fees except for legitimate reasons (i.e., "I'm knocked up!"). Are there mandatory team practices?

If/when your team chooses to practice is up to you as a group. Practices aren't required but they

are very helpful. Some teams choose to practice a little before each game, the day before each game, or just before big games. Your team captains will communicate with you regarding practices.

What if I don't get along with my team? Can I move to a new team mid-season?

We do not allow players to switch teams during the season. Please expect some level of conflict within your team from time-to-time. Our best advice is to leave your issues on the field and join everyone for post-game drinks (at Brunzies Bar & Grill - an IWFFL sponsor). If you have an issue, please take it up with your captains first before coming to the league board members.

Does IWFFL have special rules?

Yes, the IWFFL maintains their own Rules of Gameplay. Please familiarize yourself with our rules prior to the first game. Rules will be emailed to all players before the start of the season.

Who officiates the games?

Two IWFFL Referees will officiate each game. Each team is responsible for providing a referee for another match-up each week. Some teams choose to recruit an outside referee and some teams pull 1 player each week to take a turn as referee.

Does IWFFL provide medical insurance?

IWFFL does NOT provide medical insurance to players. Each player must provide their own medical insurance. We do require that ALL players sign a IWFFL General Liability Waiver as well as our General Liability Insurance Waiver acknowledging that they are willingly participating in an adult flag football league, and agree not to hold the IWFFL or Mack Park liable for any injuries or harm that may result from their participation.
